



The **Talbot Trail** is a historically significant overland route completed in the 1820s along the north shore of Lake Erie. The building of the route (almost 500 kilometres in length) was overseen by Colonel Thomas Talbot the founder of the Talbot Settlement. By means of this early road much of the north shore of Lake Erie was settled. Perfect for a motorcycle tour or scenic drive, the Talbot Trail follows Highway #3, wandering through Elgin County on its way to Windsor, Ontario.
