Works must not exceed 48" x 48".

Works must be suitably framed and the official Exhibit Label must be attached to the back of each piece entered. Copies of exhibit labels are acceptable.

- ◇ Artwork with Exhibition label attached to the back

**Eligibility:**

Any artist over 18 years old who resides in Southwestern Ontario.

Works entered must be an original composition created by the entrant. Two-dimensional work must be suitably framed and firmly wired and must not exceed framed dimensions of 48" x 48" Submitted artwork must have been created within the past three years and not previously shown at St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre. All mediums are acceptable. No copies from other artists or from published material will be allowed. No supervised work will be allowed.

**Fees and Commission**

The entry fee is \$20.00 for the first work entered and \$10.00 for each additional entry. Artists may enter a maximum of (3) pieces by any one artist to be juried into the exhibition. Cash cheque, VISA, MC and Discovery card are accepted. ENTRY FEES ARE NONREFUNDABLE.

A SALES COMMISSION OF 30% IS PAYABLE TO THE St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre. Please price accordingly.

By signing the Entry Form, you give the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre consent to use the images to advertise and promote the exhibition. The juror's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Notification will be made prior to the opening reception which will be held

**September 19, 2015 from 7-9pm.**

Any artwork not removed from the St. Thomas-Elgin public Art Centre by November 30, 2015 (unless special arrangements are made) will become the property of the St. Thomas-Elgin Public Art Centre.
